320 megawatt combined-cycle power plant.

This request includes an underground interconnection to PG&E's

Los Esteros Substation, addition of a new breaker and

reconductoring of a 1.1 to 1.3 mile portion of PG&E's San Jose-Trimble 115 kV line. Additional revisions include updates to existing Air Quality Conditions of Certification to lower emission limits for carbon monoxide and precursor organic compounds and to update

equipment descriptions.

On February 2, 2011, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project change pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Resources under Section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code.
