On April 22, 2008, the Starwood Power-Midway, LLC, filed a petition with the California Energy Commission requesting to modify the Starwood Power Project. The 120-megawatt project was certified by the Energy Commission on January 16, 2008, and is expected to begin construction on September 1, 2008. The facility will be located in an unincorporated area of western Fresno County, approximately 15 miles southwest of the City of Mendota.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED MODIFICATION

The proposed modifications in the petition would reposition buildings in the site plan, increase stack height, allow construction of a new well and add a second wastewater evaporation pond. These changes would require modification of Conditions of Certification Water Resources-1, and may require the modification of Water Resources-4, and Bio-10.

ENERGY COMMISSION REVIEW PROCEDURES

The purpose of the Energy Commission's review process is to assess the impacts of this proposal on environmental quality, public health and safety. The review process includes an evaluation of the consistency of the proposed changes with the Energy Commission's Decision and if the project, as modified, will remain in compliance with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards (Title 20, Calif. Code of Regulations, section 1769). Energy Commission staff is currently analyzing the request and will publish an analysis. A public hearing for the purpose of approving or denying the amendment proposal will subsequently be held at a regularly scheduled Energy Commission business meeting.

This Notice of Receipt is being mailed to interested parties and property owners adjacent to the project site who may want to participate in the amendment process.
