On March 29, 2013, the City of Victorville filed a petition with the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) requesting to extend the deadline to commence construction for the Victorville 2 Hybrid Power Project. The 563-megawatt facility was certified by the Energy Commission in its Decision on July 16, 2008, and construction has not begun. The facility will be located in the City of Victorville, in San Bernardino County, California. -The petition proposes to extend the deadline to commence construction from July 16, 2013, to July 16, 2018.

ENERGY COMMISSION REVIEW PROCEDURES

The deadline to commence construction, set by regulation, is otherwise five years from the effective date of the Energy Commission's final decision on the application for certification. -An applicant, before the deadline, may request, and the Commission may order, an extension for good cause (Cal.Code Regs., tit.20, §1720.3). -The purpose of the Energy Commission review process is to determine whether the project owner has shown good cause justifying the extension of the deadline to commence construction. Energy Commission staff is currently analyzing the request and will publish an analysis for this proceeding in the near future. A public hearing for the purpose of approving, denying, or modifying the amendment proposal will be held at a regularly scheduled Energy Commission business meeting.
