SUBJECT:	Discussion regarding the Mariposa Energy Project (MEP) and compliance with Contra Costa County LORS		

Patrick Roche called in response to an email I sent him on March 2<sup>nd</sup> soliciting the county's position on the Mariposa Energy Project (MEP). In a previous brief conversation he confirmed that he was not aware of minimum depth requirements the county had for water supply pipelines in agricultural land.

Patrick stated that unless a temporary office or construction trailer were proposed for the construction area on the BBID parcel, the project use would not require a use or other permit. He said that an encroachment permit for the water supply pipeline within the road right-of-way would be necessary and could be obtained from the Public Works Department. If either a temporary office or construction trailer were proposed on BBID property, a permit would be required under the municipal code.
