COMMITTEE SCHEDULING ORDER

The Project

On June 15, 2009, the California Energy Commission received an Application for Certification (AFC) from Mariposa Energy L.L.C., to construct and operate an electrical generating plant in northeastern Alameda County, California. The proposed Mariposa Energy Project power plant would be a natural gas fired, simple-cycle peaking facility rated at a gross generating capacity of 200 megawatts (MW). The proposed Mariposa Energy Project would be located approximately seven miles northwest of the City of Tracy, seven miles east of Livermore, six miles south of the community of Byron, and approximately 2.5 miles west of the community of Mountain House (located in San Joaquin County). The proposed project site is in an unincorporated area of northeastern Alameda County designated as Large Parcel Agriculture by the Alameda County East County Area Plan.

Procedural Background

The Committee held a Mandatory Status Conference at the Bethany-Byron Irrigation District headquarters near the Community of Byron on October 6, 2010, to discuss the review process and to identify issues that could affect the schedule. On October 12, 2010 the Committee issued a Scheduling Order. The original schedule required the Staff Assessment (SA) to be published on October 20, 2010. On October 19, 2010, Staff informed the parties and the Committee that the SA could not be published on October 20, 2010 due to renewable project priorities. On October 28, 2010, Staff informed the Committee that the SA will be published by 11/10/10.

The attached Revised Committee Schedule contains a list of events that must occur in order to complete the certification process. This schedule covers the period up to and including the Prehearing Conference and Evidentiary Hearing with the balance of the schedule to be determined at the Prehearing Conference. The Committee encourages the parties to consider this schedule an outer boundary and make their best efforts to

complete the milestones ahead of these dates. Some deadlines are contingent upon reviews to be conducted by federal, state, and local agencies.

The Parties shall adhere to the schedule as indicated in the "Required Interval" column of the attached schedule. The dates in the "Date" column are illustrative. In the event that a date is not met, the "Required Interval" shall govern the schedule going forward.

Based on the discussion during the Status Conference, resolution of technical issues regarding air quality, biological resources, land use, soil and water, transmission systems engineering, and traffic and transportation (aviation) is pending. Resolution of these issues shall be addressed during the data exchange process and in public meetings with the parties and interested governmental agencies. Given the complexities involved in resolving the issues, the parties are on notice that the Committee may modify the schedule at any time upon either its own motion or that of a party. [Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, § 1709.7(c).]

Order re: Status Reports

The current project schedule requires monthly status reports to be submitted by all parties to determine whether case development is progressing satisfactorily and to bring potential schedule delays or other relevant matters to the Committee's attention.

Staff is Ordered to docket and email a Status Report to the Hearing Advisor and the electronic Proof of Service list every Monday beginning November 1, 2010 until the SA and Supplemental Staff Assessment (SSA) are published. Applicant shall, and Intervenors may, serve and file status reports on the first day of each month starting November 1, 2010, and continuing until the SSA is published. The reports shall be received by the other parties and the Commission's Docket Unit, 1516 9th Street, MS 4, Sacramento, California 95814-5512, and must be filed no later than 3:00 p.m. Status reports must contain "Docket No. 09-AFC-3 Mariposa" in the caption or heading. In addition to providing printed copies to Dockets, the parties shall e-mail their status reports to the Hearing Officer and to those with e-mail addresses as indicated on the Proof-of-Service list.
