Palo Verde Solar I, LLC., the owner/operator of the Blythe Solar Project, located in the unincorporated area of eastern Riverside County, has submitted a petition to amend their Energy Commission Decision in order to transfer ownership of the Blythe Solar Project to NextEra Blythe Solar Energy Center LLC. NextEra Blythe Solar Energy Center LLC. is a wholly owned subsidiary of NextEra Energy Resources LLC. A representative of the new project owner has provided a declaration, under penalty of perjury, that NextEra Blythe Solar Energy Center LLC. agrees to comply with the conditions of certification in the Energy Commission's Decision for the Blythe Solar Project.

#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff has reviewed the petition and finds that it complies with the requirements of Title 20 of the California Code of Regulations, Section 1769(b), and recommends approval of the ownership change.

#### **CONCLUSION AND ORDER**

The California Energy Commission hereby adopts the staff's recommendation and approves the transfer of ownership from Palo Verde Solar I, LLC. to NextEra Blythe Solar Energy Center LLC effective as of the date the transfer is completed in bankruptcy court. The new owner shall inform the Energy Commission's Compliance Office Manager when the sale is completed.
