Project Description: Modifies the method of transfer of 75 acre feet of water per year to be used for enhancement of the Harper Lake Wetlands. The method of transfer was to be accomplished by transfer of water rights to the Bureau of Land Management, but was determined to be unworkable. The transfer of water will now be accomplished by an agreement that allows BLM to pump up to 75 acre feet of water per year without transfer of water rights.

On <u>November 3, 2005</u>, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Resources under Section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code.

- 1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the project.
- 3. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the project.
