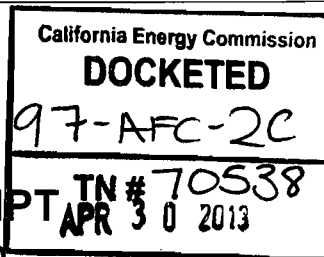

NOTICE OF RECEIPT
PETITION TO AMEND
the CALIFORNIA ENERGY COMMISSION DECISION for the
SUTTER ENERGY CENTER (97-AFC-2C)

On March 22, 2013, the Calpine Construction Finance Company, L.P. (CCFP), filed a petition with the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) requesting to modify the Sutter Energy Center (SEC). The 578-megawatt facility was certified by the Energy Commission in its Decision on April 14, 1999, and began commercial operation on July 2, 2001. The facility is located near Yuba City in Sutter County, California.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED MODIFICATION

The modifications proposed in the petition would allow the SEC to operate more efficiently and effectively by adding a new auxiliary boiler, enlarging the existing air-cooled condenser, and constructing a new, 230-kV-to-500-kV step-up substation, and a new, approximately 1.71-mile-long, underground 230-kV generator tie-line that would connect the facility to PG&E's Table Mountain-to-Tesla 500-kV transmission line.

ENERGY COMMISSION AMENDMENT REVIEW PROCEDURES

The purpose of the Energy Commission's review process is to assess the impacts of this proposal on environmental quality and on public health and safety. The review process includes an evaluation of the consistency of the proposed changes with the Energy Commission's Decision and a determination on whether the facility, as modified, would remain in compliance with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards (Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769). Energy Commission staff is currently analyzing the request and will publish an analysis in the near future. A public hearing for the purpose of approving, denying, or modifying the amendment proposal will be held at a regularly scheduled Energy Commission business meeting.

This Notice of Receipt is being mailed to interested parties and property owners adjacent to the facility site who may want to participate in the amendment process.


