**BACKGROUND:**

The OGS AFC indicated that one project identified that could impact traffic conditions from a cumulative perspective in the vicinity of the proposed project site is the River Oaks Crossing, which is proposed on property south of the project site and BNSF railroad tracks. However, at the time of preparation of the AFC, no construction date has been set for this project so the potential for overlapping construction schedules was unknown.

**DISCUSSION:**

Ms. Willis confirmed that no construction timeframe is proposed or known for this project. The River Oaks Crossing project is a proposed retail development, with construction occurring as private retailers purchase space and construct individual structures. As of January 3, 2011 no construction is proposed.
