Under Title 20 California Code of Regulations § 2505, Mojave Solar LLC is submitting this application for confidential designation for the attached documents in connection with the Mojave Solar Project (Project) Application for Certification (AFC).

Mojave Solar, LLC requests that the attached (see list below) containing sensitive cultural resources information be kept confidential.

- Cultural Resources Technical Report, Attachment 2 Records Search
- Cultural Resources Technical Report, Attachment 3 Contact Program
- Cultural Resources Technical Report, Attachment 4 Results Maps
- Cultural Resources Technical Report, Attachment 5 Site Records

Mojave Solar, LLC requests that the California Energy Commission (Commission) keep this information confidential permanently. The requested time frame is consistent with the definition of public records contained in California Government Code Section 6254.10. Section 6254.10 indicates that:

Nothing in this chapter requires disclosure of records that relate to archaeological site information and reports maintained by, or in the possession of, the Department of Parks and Recreation, the State Historical Resources Commission, the State Lands Commission, the Native American Heritage Commission, another state agency, or local agency, including the records that the agency obtains through a consultation process between a California Native American tribe and a state or local agency.

The attached provide just the type of information discussed in the above–cited Government code section. Consistent with the intent of California Codes Section 6254.10, such information should be considered a confidential permanently.

Cultural resources are assets providing insight into prior cultures and lose a great deal of value if they are improperly disturbed. Publication of the location and specific descriptions of the assets may invite the curious, who may unwittingly disrupt or destroy the assets, and even worse may encourage destruction or theft from the sites. This in order to protect the integrity of these sites, these site descriptions and locations should be kept confidential.

The information in a non-confidential, summary form is already included in the cultural section of the AFC. Making the information contained in the attached documents public would render the information useless, and Mojave Solar, LLC believes that the Commission and staff will need the detailed information provided in these reports to properly carry out their analysis. The public document included in the AFC can serve as generalized basis for the Commission's analysis without disclosing information that could lead to damage to the sites.

For the reasons specified above and the specific statutory protection provided for cultural records, the Commission should designate the attached documents as confidential.

I state under penalty of perjury, that the information contained in this application for confidential designation is true, correct, and complete to the best of my knowledge, and that I am authorized to make the application on behalf of Mojave Solar, LLC.
