> Abengoa Solar, LLC filed an application for certification (AFC) for the Abengoa Mojave Solar (AMS) project on August 10, 2009. The AMS AFC was found Data Adequate by the California Energy Commission on October 21, 2009, beginning the AFC review process.

The President and Congress have underscored the need for accelerated development of renewable energy projects in California with the passing of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009. The Act specifically directs economic stimulus funding to qualified projects that begin construction by December 1, 2010. The AMS project is requesting ARRA funding which has required an accelerated project schedule and the preparation of a single Staff Assessment as opposed to a Preliminary Staff Assessment and Final Staff Assessment.

Issues Identification Report

On October 22, 2009 staff filed the Issues Identification Report. This report identified potential concerns with water impacts to the Mojave River Groundwater Basin. The report also included a project schedule based upon the Renewable Energy Action Team Milestones to Permit California Renewable Portfolio Standard Energy Projects by December, 2010.

Data Request Set 1A (nos 1-93) and Set 1B (nos 1-86)

On October 22, 2009 staff filed Data Request Set 1A (nos 1-93) and on October 26, 2009 staff docketed Data Request Set 1B (nos 1-86).

Applicant Responses

On November 11, 2009 the applicant requested 30 days of additional time for certain data requests from Set 1A. These extension requests include: 5 Air Quality data requests, 12 Biological Resources data requests and 5 Land Use data requests. On November 16, 2009 the applicant requested 30 days of additional time for certain data requests from Set 1B. These requests include: 11 Cultural Resources data requests, and 15 Water Resources data requests.

The applicant has also objected to one data request in each of the following sections; Air Quality, Land Use, Transmission System Design and Waste Management.

Data Responses

The applicant submitted Data Responses to Data Request Set 1A on November 24, 2009 and Data Responses to Data Request Set 1B were submitted on November 25, 2009. Staff is currently reviewing the information.

Data Response and Issues Resolution Workshop

Staff has filed a notice for a Data Response and Issues Resolution Workshop for Tuesday, December 8, 2009 at the Energy Commission's Hearing Room B at 1:00 pm.

Project Schedule

Because additional time has been requested by the applicant for the preparation of critical data responses, project deliverables will be delayed. Staff will need additional time to review information and modify staff analyses as needed. Staff continues to review project data and are working on the staff assessment. The attached AMS schedule identifies a Staff Assessment being issued 2 weeks later than previously anticipated, based upon expected delays in the receipt of required data request and workshop information.

Staff is currently working to meet the attached project schedule. Staff will continue to keep the Committee apprised of current work product and critical timelines.
