California Unions for Reliable Energy ("CURE") submits this issues statement pursuant to the Committee's April 5, 2010 Notice of Mandatory Status Conference for the Blythe Solar Power Project. The Committee's notice requires parties to state what obstacles may exist that would hinder completion of this proceeding by September 2010 and to provide a proposed schedule for the remainder of this proceeding.

The Staff Assessment/Draft Environmental Impact Statement ("SA/DEIS") was published on March 11, 2010. The 90-day National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) comment period for the SA/DEIS commenced on April 6, 2010.

CURE is currently reviewing the SA/DEIS and identifying resource areas that may require further data and analyses. For example, Staff states that its analysis of biological resources, cultural resources, land use, reliability, soil and water resources, traffic and transportation, and transmission system engineering is undetermined. CURE notes that Staff does not yet have sufficient information to determine the biological impacts of the Applicant's proposed channel reconfiguration and post-Project flooding conditions. Similarly, surveys of certain special status species will not begin until Spring of 2010. Furthermore, the Riverside County Airport Land Use Commission has continued its consistency determination until May 13, 2010.

Because the parties may require further information from the

Applicant in order to complete the Project impact and LORS compliance

analysis, CURE is considering data requests concerning the above-referenced and other resource areas.

In light of the gaps in information and the extent of Staff's analysis, a firm schedule may not be feasible. However, based on facts known at this time, CURE proposes the following:
