SUBJECT:	Status of Jurisdictional Determination for Blythe		

I asked Mr. Mace if he had reviewed the jurisdictional delineation for Blythe yet. He had looked a map of the site and his preliminary thoughts were that the drainages were isolated waterways. I sent him an electronic copy of the jurisdictional report to provide him with more detailed information. He was going to talk to his Branch Chief about this project, and said that he might be able to get a confirmed jurisdictional status soon. Normally the process can take as long as six months, but with the AARA funded projects they would likely shorten that considerably. He thought it likely that they would not be considered waters of the U.S.
