California Unions for Reliable Energy ("CURE") submits this issues statement pursuant to the Committee's April 5, 2010 Notice of Mandatory Status Conference for the Palen Solar Power Project. The Committee's notice requires parties to state what obstacles may exist that would hinder completion of this proceeding by September 2010 and to provide a proposed schedule for the remainder of this proceeding.

The Staff Assessment/Draft Environmental Impact Statement ("SA/DEIS") was published on March 18, 2010. CURE is currently reviewing the SA/DEIS and identifying resource areas that may require further analysis. For example, in the SA/DEIS, Staff states that the effectiveness of mitigation and compliance with laws, ordinances and regulations in the areas of air quality, cultural resources, soil and water resources, and transmission system engineering is undetermined. In addition, CURE notes that surveys and development of mitigation for biological resources are still underway. Because the parties may require further information from the applicant in order to complete the impact analysis and identification of mitigation, CURE is considering data requests concerning these resource areas.

In light of these outstanding issues, it is difficult to determine an appropriate schedule. Nevertheless, CURE recommends the following

schedule, which could be adjusted in either direction depending on the pace at which additional information is provided and analysis performed:

Publish SA Addendum/Revised DEIS May 2010

Publish SSA/FEIS July 30, 2010

Applicant Testimony August 6, 2010

Intervenor Testimony August 20, 2010

Rebuttal Testimony September 1, 2010

Prehearing Conference Statements September 8, 2010

Prehearing Conference September 15, 2010

Evidentiary hearings Sept. 22, 23, 24, 2010

Presiding Members Proposed Decision TBD
