The FSA will serve as staff's formal testimony in evidentiary hearings to be held by the Energy Commission's Committee assigned to hear this case. The Committee will hold evidentiary hearings in July that will be noticed separately and will consider the recommendations presented by the staff, applicant, intervenors, government agencies, and the public, prior to proposing its decision. The Energy Commission will make the final decision, including findings, after the Committee's publication of its Presiding Member's Proposed Decision.

SUMMARY OF THE PROPOSED HUNTINGTON BEACH ENERGY PROJECT

On June 27, 2012, AES Southland Corporation submitted an AFC to the Energy Commission seeking permission to construct and operate a power generation facility, HBEP, which would be located entirely within the footprint of the existing Huntington Beach Generating Station, an operating power plant. The proposed project is located in the city of Huntington Beach, just north of the intersection of the Pacific Coast Highway and Newland Street. The proposed HBEP would be a natural-gas fired, combined-cycle, air-cooled, 939-megawatt (MW) electrical generating facility that would replace the AES Huntington Beach Generating Station.

SUMMARY OF STAFF'S FINAL CONCLUSIONS

Energy Commission staff concludes that the HBEP complies with all LORS, and with the implementation of the recommended mitigation measures described in the conditions of certification, potential environmental impacts of the HBEP would be mitigated to levels of less than significant.
