PETITION TO INTERVENE BY
THE CENTER FOR BIOLOGICAL DIVERSITY

June 1, 2010

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Pursuant to sections 1207 and 1712 of Title 20 of the California Code of Regulations, the Center for Biological Diversity petitions to intervene in this proceeding.

The Center for Biological Diversity is a nonprofit organization whose mission is to protect imperiled species and their habitats through science, policy and environmental law. For more than a decade, the Center for Biological Diversity has worked to conserve and recover the rare, imperiled, and threatened and endangered species in the California deserts. The Center has advocated for protections for the desert tortoise, Mojave fringe toed lizard, and other imperiled species in the California deserts on public and private lands in order to reduce impacts to species and habitats from development, vehicles, predation, and other threats in the California deserts. The Center for Biological Diversity has also participated in the approval process for many site-specific projects and in the planning processes for public lands throughout the California Desert Conservation Area (“CDCA”) including for the Northern and Eastern Colorado Desert Coordinated Management Plan amendments to the CDCA which include the area where the proposed project is found.

The Center is currently an intervenor in two other proceedings before the Commission for large-scale solar projects in the California desert. The project at issue in this matter will directly impact many desert resources including, but not limited to, the desert tortoise and its critical habitat, Mojave fringe toed and its habitat, other imperiled plants and wildlife, and scarce water resources.

The interests of the board, staff, and members of the Center for Biological Diversity are directly affected by the project at issue in this matter. These immediate interests include, but are not limited to, the survival and recovery of the Mojave fringe-toed lizard, the preservation of its habitat, protection of the desert tortoise and its critical habitat, conservation of rare and imperiled native plants, conservation of other wildlife species found in this area including desert bighorn, conservation and protection of water resources, and cumulative impacts to these and other resources.

The Center for Biological Diversity wishes to participate fully in all phases of this proceeding. Filings should be served on Lisa Belenky and Ileene Anderson at the addresses listed below. Email service is preferred.

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
