I. INFORMATIONAL PRESENTATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Energy Commission has designated a Committee consisting of Vice Chair Crowley and Commissioner Kevorkian to conduct proceedings in the above-captioned matter. The Committee will hold a public INFORMATIONAL PRESENTATION on the Application for Certification of the Sacramento Cogeneration Authority's Procter & Gamble Cogeneration Project as follows:

Project Description. The Sacramento Cogeneration Authority (SCA), composed of the Sacramento Municipal Utility District (SMUD) and the Sacramento Municipal Utility Financing Authority (SMUDFA), proposes to construct and operate a 171 MW gas-fired cogeneration power plant on a 10-acre site adjacent to the Procter & Gamble manufacturing facility near the intersection of Power Inn Road and Fruitridge Road in the city of Sacramento. The Central California Traction Company rail line borders the site on the north, and 83rd Street borders the site on the east. Power Inn Road is approximately 0.4 mile to the west, and Fruitridge Road is approximately .35 mile to the south. The cogeneration project will process steam for the Procter & Gamble facility while simultaneously generating electricity for sale to SMUD.

<u>Purpose of the Informational Presentation.</u> Members of the public and representatives of governmental agencies are welcome to attend the Informational Presentation and to offer comments on the application. The Applicant will explain



plans for developing the proposed power plant and related facilities. The Energy Commission staff will explain the administrative proceedings involved in reviewing the application. The entire case proceedings are expected to take approximately twelve months.

The Commission's Associate Public Adviser will be present to assist members of the public who are interested in participating in the proceedings. The Public Adviser's office may be reached at (916) 654-4489 or, toll free, (800) 822-6228.

II. SCHEDULING CONFERENCE

The Committee will conduct a Scheduling Conference immediately following the Informational Presentation on the same date and at the same location noticed above. The purpose of the Scheduling Conference is to establish a schedule for procedural matters necessary to complete the proceedings in a timely manner.

III. SITE VISIT

Following the Informational Presentation and Scheduling Conference, the Applicant will host a visit to the Procter & Gamble site where the power plant will be built. Members of the public and governmental agencies are invited to participate in the site visit.
