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Subject: **Replacement Pool Pump Motor Pre-Rulemaking Proceeding to Resume**

The California Energy Commission will resume pre-rulemaking activities on the replacement pool pump motor topic after participating in negotiations with the pool pump motor industry and energy advocates. The goal of the negotiations was to provide the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) with a recommendation for a national test procedure and efficiency standard for pool pump motors that would complement the recently completed DOE dedicated purpose pool pump rule.

The Energy Commission will resume the replacement pool pump motor proceeding since the negotiation did not result in a consensus recommendation to the DOE for a pool pump motor standard.
