# Overview

- **Rulemaking covers entire Title 20 Appliance Efficiency Regulations**
- **Provides clarification, improves readability, and reflects current laws**
- **No changes to underlying energy and water efficiency standards**



# Changes to Reflect Federal Law

## Adding and amending:

- Definitions
- Test procedures
- Energy performance standards



# State-Specific Changes

- **When preempted by federal law:**
  - Removing standards and test procedures that are now federally regulated
- **Aligning state test procedures with federal test procedures**



# Appliance Certification

## Modernized Appliance Efficiency Database System (MAEDbS)

- Updating language
- When necessary, updating data parameters





# Modernizing Communication

- Database-related communication will be done electronically
- Email notifications when appliance models are archived
