Notice of Availability Anaheim Public Utilities Integrating Resource Plan Filing

Senate Bill 350 (de León, Chapter 547, Statutes of 2015) requires publicly owned utilities (POU) with annual electrical demand exceeding 700 gigawatt-hours to adopt integrated resource plans (IRP) by January 1, 2019. POU IRPs must be submitted to the Energy Commission for review by April 30, 2019. POU IRPs submitted to the Energy Commission will be posted for 30 calendar days for public comment.

Upon receipt, the Energy Commission will review the IRP and determine whether it is consistent with the requirements of SB 350. The Energy Commission will consider requirements in the *Publicly Owned Utility Integrated Resource Plan Submission and Review Guidelines, Second Edition (Guidelines)* as well as public comment related to the consistency of the IRP with SB 350 requirements as part of its review and determination.

On July 30, 2018, Anaheim Public Utilities submitted their complete IRP filing to the Energy Commission along with the four standardized reporting tables. The standardized reporting tables provide data on capacity and energy resources each POU plans to use and the projected progress towards greenhouse gas emission reduction targets. The reporting tables provide supporting information for the Anaheim Public Utilities IRP.

Interested stakeholders may submit written comments to the Dockets Unit by **5:00 p.m. on August 31, 2018**. The Energy Commission is using an electronic commenting system to accept comments. Please follow the instructions below to provide written comments.

1. Go to the Energy Commission's website: <http://www.energy.ca.gov/e-filing/>.
2. Click "Comment on a Proceeding" in the Additional Information box.
3. Type "**18-IRP-01**" into the "Select a Proceeding" field.
4. Click "Continue" to Add a Comment. Commenters are required to input their full name, email address, and comment title.

5. Comment title should be “Jane Doe or Company Name Comment Publicly Owned Utility Integrated Resource Plan Guidelines.”
6. Type comments into the “Comment Text” field or upload a document with comments. Comments should be in a downloadable, searchable format such as Microsoft® Word (.doc or .docx) or Adobe® Acrobat® (.pdf).
7. Enter the CAPTCHA that is used to prevent spamming on the website. Then click on “Agree and Submit your Comments.”
