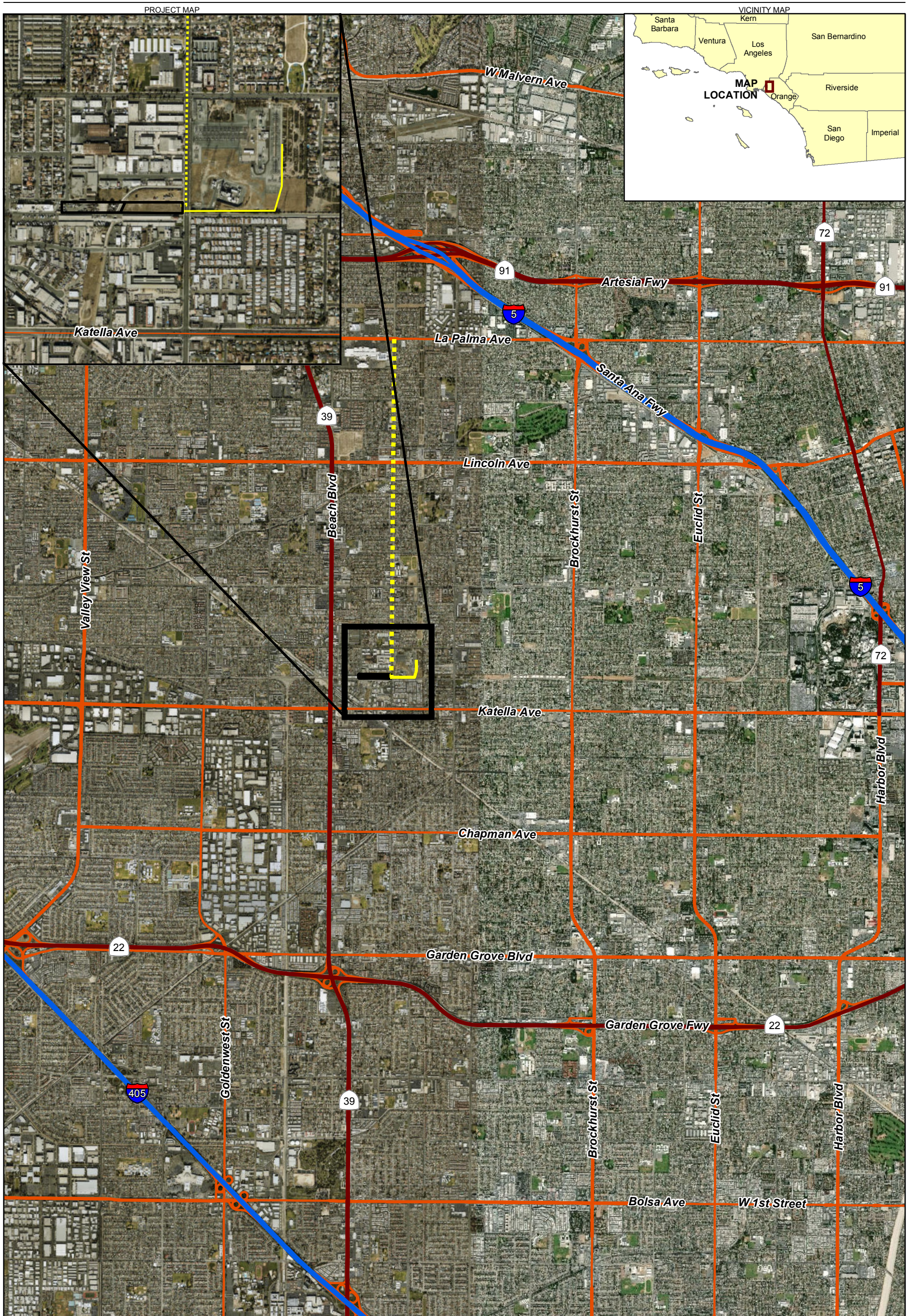

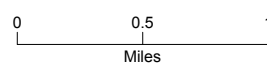

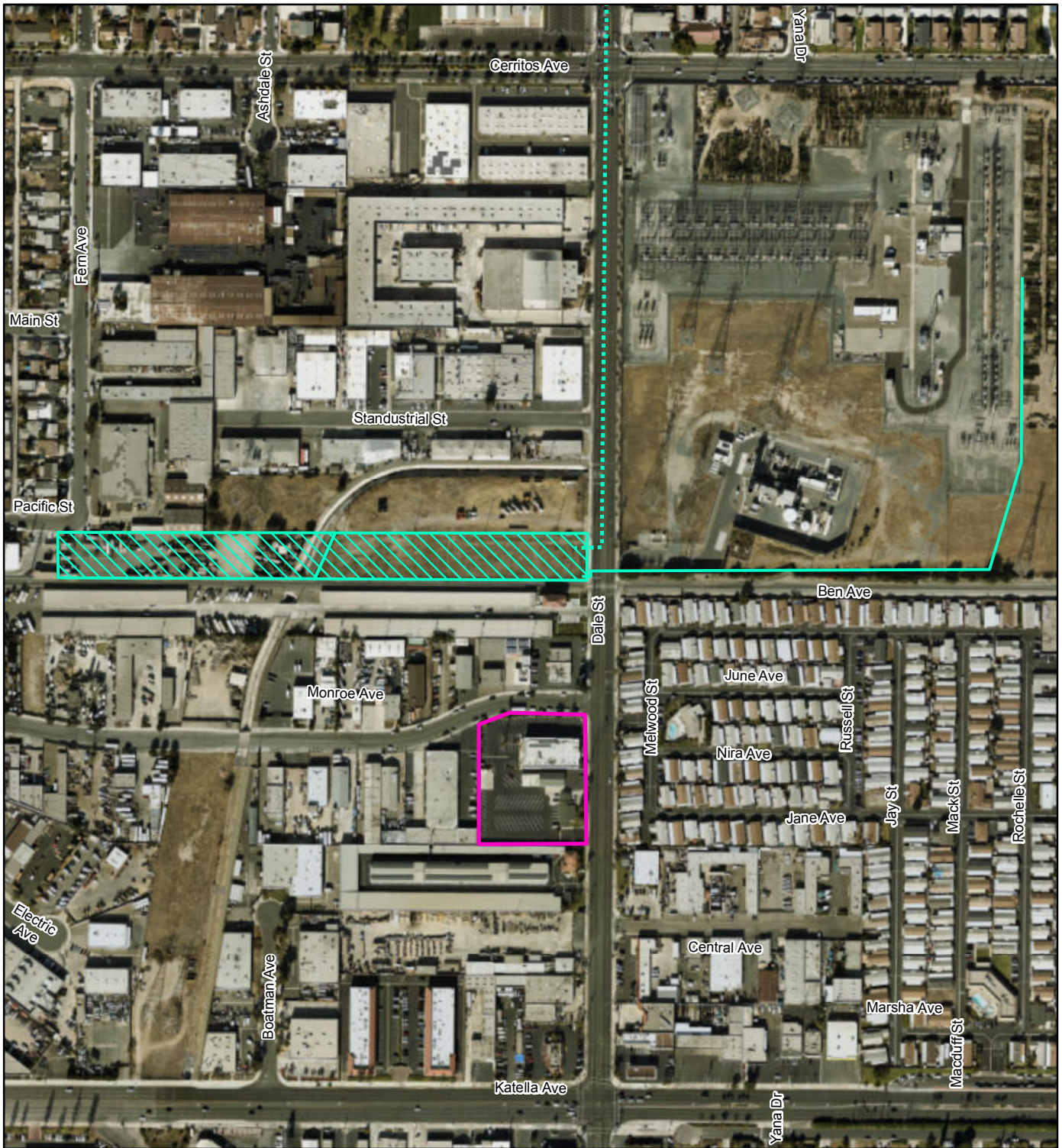

 Stanton, California

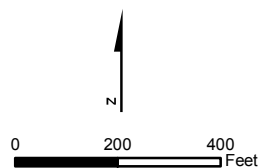

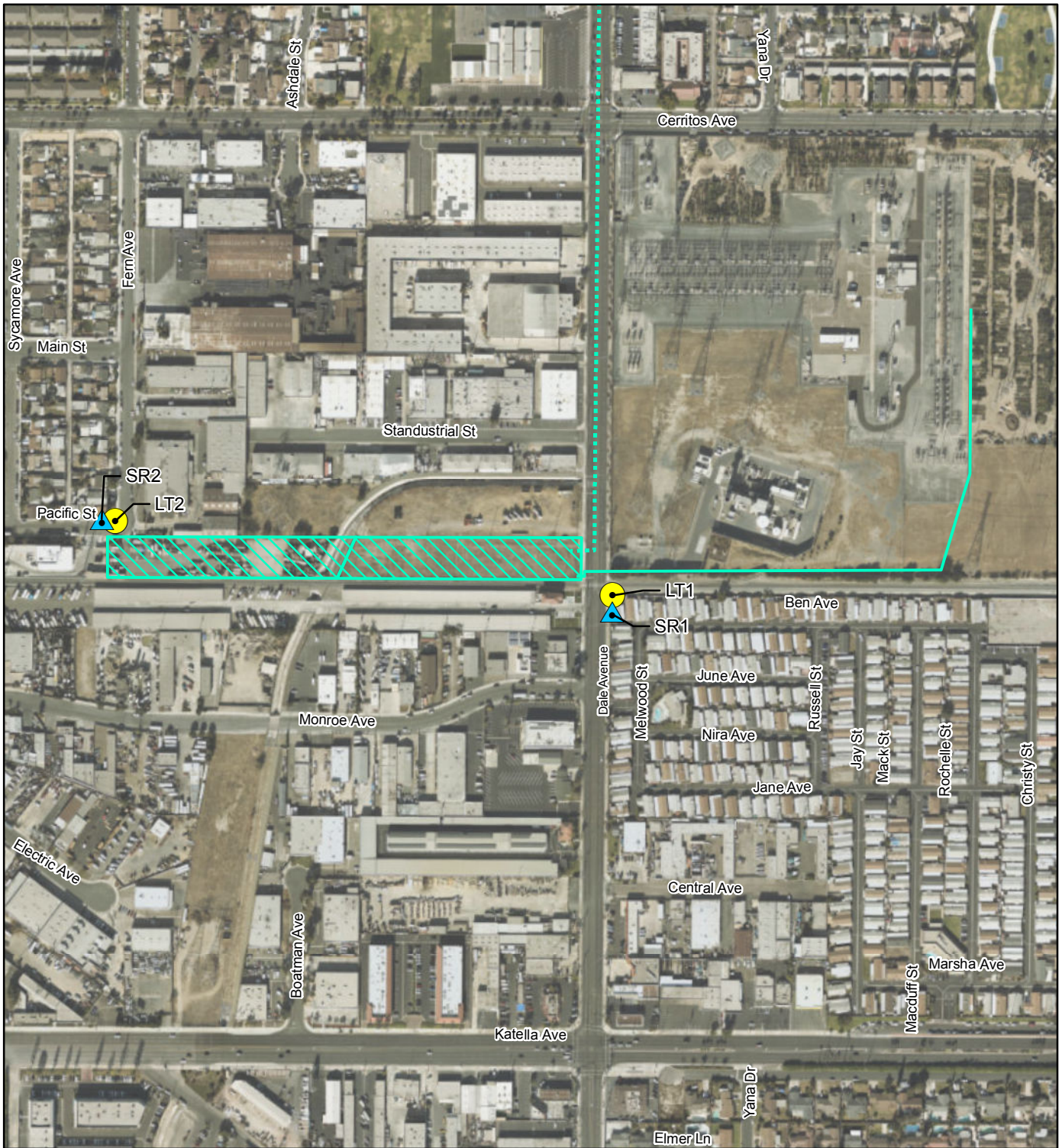

 Stanton, California








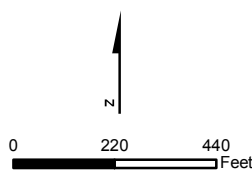
