**Project Description:**

Originally licensed on July 2, 2002 (01-AFC-12), and recertified on March 16, 2005 (03-AFC-2, Phase 1), as a simple-cycle power plant, the Los Esteros Critical Energy Facility (LECEF) project was required to recertify or convert to combined-cycle operation within 3 years of the original decision date. The current project application (03-AFC-2, Phase 2) contains an application to license the conversion of the LECEF to a combined-cycle facility, adding a steam turbine generator and associated equipment that increases the electrical output by 140 megawatts (MW) to a total output of 320 MW.

Phase 2, licensing the conversion of the LECEF to a combined-cycle facility has completed the Application for Certification process by the Energy Commission.

The project is a 180 megawatt (MW) simple cycle power plant, with four GE LM6000 natural gas-fired turbines and associated electrical generation equipment. Recycled water is used for cooling and for enhanced turbine efficiency. Power is currently supplied to the grid via an approved 150 foot-long permanent connection through the Pacific Gas & Electric Los Esteros Substation-Nortech 115 kV transmission line, but will transfer the interconnection to a 230 kV connection point at the Silicon Valley Power Switching Station recently build next to the LECEF. Selective catalytic reduction, and an oxidation catalyst are employed to reduce air pollutant emissions of NOx, SO2, and CO, and will continue to be used within the Heat Recovery Steam Generator system to be added during the conversion to combined-cycle operation.

On October 11, 2006, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project, 03-AFC-2, Phase 2, pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Resources under Section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code.
