Dear Commissioners McAllister and Douglas:


On January 14, 2016, the Committee for the Petition to Amend the Huntington Beach Energy Project (Petition) issued a Committee Scheduling Order. The Order indicated that the parties shall file status reports on or before the first of each month, commencing February 1, 2016. Status reports shall inform the Committee whether or not case development is progressing satisfactorily and bring potential schedule delays and other relevant matters to the Committee's attention. The Committee further requested that the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) file status reports in the event that the timing of completion of its tasks fall outside the intervals identified in the schedule attached to the Order.

On May 13, 2016 a courtesy copy of the draft PDOC was provided to CEC's staff for review to facilitate meeting the expedited schedule for the CEC process. In addition, SCAQMD on May 6, 2016 received from the National Park Service, one of the Federal Land Manager's, determination for PSD impact analysis, which states in part, "We agree the proposed controls represent BACT and we do not expect the project to substantially affect any NPS areas. Therefore, we have no need to provide further comments on the application." SCAQMD is in the process of completing edits on the draft PDOC and it is estimated it would be finalized by June 3, 2016.
