The following is a summary of the activities related to the Huntington Beach Energy Project (HBEP-PTA).

Procedural Activities:

On August 10, 2016, Energy Commission staff docketed a "Limited Notice to Proceed for Demolition Activities" for the remaining portion of the old Unit 5 peaker, oil and fuel tanks, and demolition of the containment berms surrounding the tank area.

On August 19, 2016, the HBEP-PTA Committee held a status conference to discuss schedules and remaining data requests that will be used to finish the FSA.

Staff is working towards publishing the Final Staff Assessment (FSA) two weeks after the FDOC is published, per the Committee's August 29, 2016 Scheduling Order.

Coordination with Agencies:

Recent correspondence with the South Coast Air Quality Management District (Air District) with Energy Commission staff indicated that the Air District is preparing their responses to comments received on the Preliminary Determination of Compliance (PDOC). The Air District is targeting the publication of the Final Determination of Compliance (FDOC) in September 2016.

Staff will continue coordinating with the agencies involved with the amendment review, including the city of Huntington Beach, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, California Department of Fish and Wildlife, SCAQMD, the Huntington Beach Wetlands Conservancy, and California Coastal Commission. The California Coastal Commission comments were docketed on August 15, 2016.
