Background

Energy Commission staff will conduct a public workshop to solicit stakeholder input on the Energy Commission's upcoming design-build competition titled *The Next EPIC Challenge: Reimagining Affordable Mixed-Use Development in a Carbon-Constrained Future*.

The Next EPIC Challenge is a two-phase competition that will challenge teams to design and build a mixed-used development concept capable of achieving zero greenhouse gas emissions. Sixteen teams are expected to be selected and funded for

the Design Phase of the competition and the opportunity to compete for the Build Phase.

At the workshop, Energy Commission staff will present the draft parameters, rules and timeline for the competition to the public. After the staff presentation, workshop participants will have the opportunity to comment and suggest changes to the competition rules and parameters.

Public Comment

Oral comments: Staff will accept oral comments during the workshop. Comments may be limited to three minutes per speaker. Any comments may become part of the public record in this proceeding.

Written comments: Written comments should be submitted to the Dockets Unit by 5:00 p.m. on January 17, 2019. Written comments will be also accepted at the workshop, however, the Commission may not have time to review them before the conclusion of the meeting.
