## **Efficient building electrification is needed to meet Calif GHG goals**

Please adopt the IEPR as written, and do NOT accept the self-interested arguments for including a damaging "renewable gas" option. The limited quantities of renewable gas are needed for uses for which there is not an electrification alternative.

The route forward is clear via electrification using high efficiency heat pumps, and California's increasingly renewable power. Any further investment in gas infra-structure represents stranded assets and the potential for climate damaging methane leakage.
