**NOTICE OF STAFF APPROVAL**  
**PETITION FOR CHANGE OF OPERATIONAL CONTROL**  
**for the**  
**TRACY COMBINED-CYCLE POWER PLANT (08-AFC-07C)**

On February 1, 2019 a petition was filed and docketed with the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) requesting to change the operational control of Tracy Combined-Cycle Power Plant to MRP San Joaquin Energy LLC. The 314-megawatt combined cycle electric generating facility, was certified by the Energy Commission on March 24, 2010, and began commercial operation on November 1, 2012. The facility is located southwest of the City of Tracy, about 20 miles southwest of Stockton, in an unincorporated portion of San Joaquin County, California.

The petition is requesting to change operational control of the facility to MRP San Joaquin Energy LLC. A statement describing the change in operational control, signed under penalty of perjury by a representative of MRP San Joaquin Energy LLC, was submitted as required by Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769(b). The statement affirms that MRP San Joaquin Energy LLC understands the conditions of certification and agrees to comply with those conditions.

Staff has reviewed the petition and has determined that the petition meets the requirements of Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769(b). Accordingly, Staff hereby approves the petition to change operational control. Any person may file an objection to staff's approval within 14 days of the filing of this notice. Any such objection must state the grounds for the objection. If a person files such an objection, the petition will be considered by the Energy Commission at a noticed business meeting or hearing.

An objection to staff's approval may be submitted using the Energy Commission's e-Commenting feature. Go to the Energy Commission's webpage for this facility, cited above, click on the "Submit e-Comment" link, and follow the instructions in the on-line form. Be sure to include the facility name in your comments. Once submitted, the Energy Commission Dockets Unit reviews and approves your comments, and you will receive an e-mail with a link to them.
