We are seeking addition clarification regarding the following item, Section 2: "The Energy Commission may authorize subsequent batches of stations (one batch at a time) on a first-come, first-served basis if: (A) all stations under previously-approved batches have approval to build from their respective authorities having jurisdiction (AHJs) within 18 months of the Energy Commission authorizing the station(s) under the agreement."

Question 1: what occurs if all stations under the previously-approved batch do not have approval to build from their respective AHJ within 18 months? For example, are the remaining batches in the awarded tranche disqualified from funding?

Question 2: if a station under the previously-approved batch has become non-viable for permitting, can it be removed from the batch? Provided the remaining stations in the previously-approved batch have approval to build from their respective AHJ within 18 months, would this action render this condition for Energy Commission authorization of subsequent batches of stations met?
