Project Location: Marsh Landing Generating Station, located in the city of Antioch, California.

Project Description: Marsh Landing Generating Station is a simple-cycle, natural gas-fired, 760-megawatt (MW) facility. The amendment requested and approved is installing a battery energy storage system and associated equipment. The batteries would be used to start the gas turbines to restart the power plant in the event of a blackout to support the California Independent System Operator's directed restoration of the electrical grid in response to an emergency condition (also known as "black start" capability). The proposed project consists of installing up to 7 MW/3.6-megawatt-hour lithium-ion batteries in 2 metal enclosures.

The Energy Commission produced an EIR-equivalent analysis of the Marsh Landing Generating Station as part of its original licensing proceeding, which culminated in the grant of license on August 25, 2010. Based on the entire record of this proceeding, including staff's analysis, and the Marsh Landing Generating Station Commission Decision and the environmental analysis of the project contained therein, the Energy Commission concluded that the proposed modifications will not result in any significant impacts to public health and safety, or to the environment.

Additionally, the Energy Commission concluded that the proposed changes to the project contained in the Petition to Amend, and Energy Commission staff's analysis thereof, do not meet the criteria requiring production of subsequent or supplemental environmental review as specified in Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15162(a); therefore, no subsequent or supplemental EIR-equivalent review or documentation was required. On March 12, 2019, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Natural Resources under Section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code.
