FOR POST CERTIFICATION PETITION FOR CHANGE IN PROJECT DESIGN, OPERATION, OR PERFORMANCE for the

ALAMITOS ENERGY CENTER (13-AFC-01C)

On April 4, 2019, a petition was filed with the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) requesting to modify the combined cycle gas turbine (CCGT) and simple

cycle gas turbine (SCGT) operating hours to optimize project operations and to achieve an operating profile that more closely mirrors the Project Owner's affiliated project located in Huntington Beach.

The petition was docketed by Energy Commission staff on April 4, 2019. The Alamitos Energy Center is a 1,040-megawatt combined cycle electric generating station, was certified by the Energy Commission on April 12, 2017, and began construction on June 9, 2017. The facility is located at 690 North Studebaker Road in the City of Long Beach.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED CHANGES

This petition for a post-Certification project change includes the following changes:

- Increase the CCGT operating hours from 4,460 per unit per year (including starts and stops) to 6,545 hours per year per unit (including starts and stops);
- Decrease the SCGT operating hours from 2,360 per unit per year (including starts and stops) to 1,060 hours per year per unit (including starts and stops);
- Modify air emission limits commensurate with the modification of operating hours; and
- No changes to the number or type of startup and shutdowns are required or proposed.

This Notice of Receipt has been mailed to the Energy Commission's facility mail list of interested parties and property owners adjacent to the facility site. The petition requesting the project change has been docketed and is available on the Energy Commission's webpage for this facility at:
