# Background

- *2015 (original) and 2016 Update Existing Buildings Energy Efficiency Action Plan*
  - Assembly Bill 758 (Skinner, Chapter 470, Statutes of 2009)
  - 10-year roadmap to advance energy efficiency
  - Focus on residential, public, and commercial buildings
- *Senate Bill 350 Doubling Energy Efficiency by 2030 Report*
  - Senate Bill 350 (De Leon, Chapter 547, Statutes of 2015)
  - Target setting report to set a baseline toward achieving a cumulative doubling of energy efficiency by January 1, 2030
  - Expanded to agriculture, industry, and new construction.



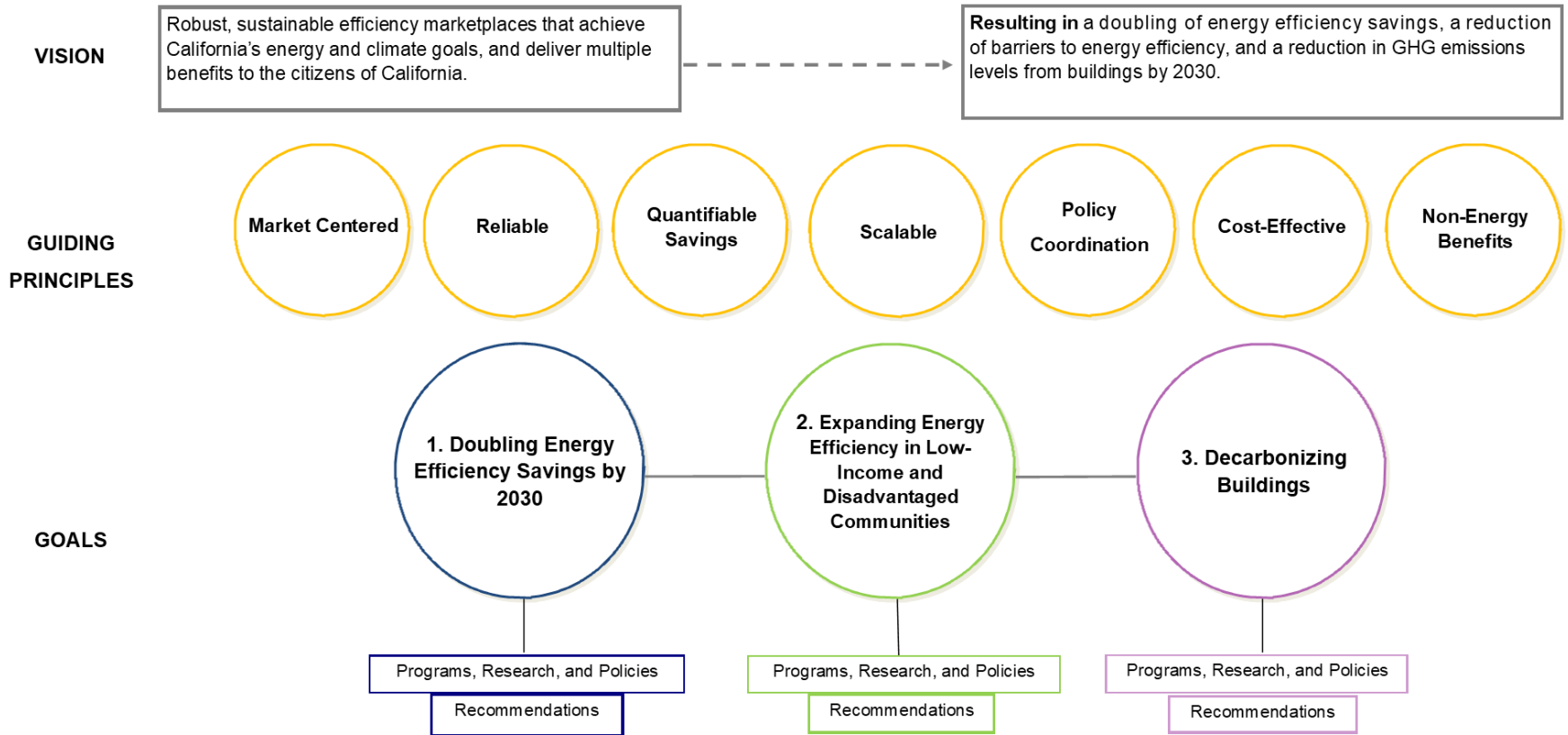
# New Energy Efficiency Policy Report

## 2019 California Energy Efficiency Action Plan

- Includes three policy drivers
  - AB 758
  - SB 350
  - AB 3232
- Also include energy efficiency content from:
  - SB 350 Low-Income Barriers Study
  - Clean Energy Low Income Multifamily Buildings Action Plan
- Update energy efficiency savings targets under SB 350
- Establish new savings targets for agriculture, industry, and conservation voltage reduction
- Make policy recommendations to CA State Legislature
- Revise biennially with intermediate updates in the *Integrated Energy Policy Report*
