1 2 9:01 a.m. 3 PRESIDING MEMBER DOUGLAS: Good morning, everyone. 4 Today we will convene a committee meeting for the Hidden 5 Hills Solar Electric Generating System. As explained in the 6 February 20, 2013 Notice of Extension of Evidentiary 7 Hearings, the committee meeting is being held for the 8 primary purpose of conducting Committee deliberations in 9 closed session. 10 Let's see here. I'll introduce because we do have 11 staff here. We may have other parties on the phone, 12 although I don't see any yet. Mr. Brehler, if you could 13 introduce yourself for the record. 14 MR. BREHLER: Good morning, Commissioner Douglas 15 and Hearing Officer Celli. This is Pippin Brehler, senior 16 staff counsel, representing staff. PRESIDING MEMBER DOUGLAS: Thank you. Do we have 17 18 anyone from applicant on the phone? 19 (No response.) 20 HEARING OFFICER CELLI: Nobody. 21 PRESIDING MEMBER DOUGLAS: All right. Ιt 22 certainly looks like we have nobody else signed on. Do we 23 have anyone else on the phone right now? 24 (No response.) 25 PRESIDING MEMBER DOUGLAS: We'll wait five minutes and give people a chance to show up.

HEARING OFFICER CELLI: Do you want me to give the procedure?

4 PRESIDING MEMBER DOUGLAS: Yes.

5 HEARING OFFICER CELLI: Okay. Kenneth Celli, 6 Hearing Advisor.

Today's agenda is divided into four parts.

First, the open meeting will be convened, which is what we are doing now.

Secondly, public comment will be taken.

Third, the closed session will begin.

And finally, the open meeting will reopen simply to announce the conclusion of the closed session and adjourn.

The closed session will be conducted in accordance with Government Code Section 111126. That's 11126, subdivision (c)(3), which allows a state body, including a delegated -- I'm going to read this all over again.

The closed session will be conducted in accordance with Government Code Section 11126, subdivision (c)(3), which allows a state body, including a delegated committee, to hold a closed session to deliberate on a decision to be reached in a proceeding the state body was required by law to conduct.

Now, the record should reflect that both

Commissioner Douglas and Commissioner Hochschild are here with advisors Kelly Foley and Jim Bartridge.

At this time Mr. Brehler has a question so let's hear from Mr. Brehler.

MR. BREHLER: Good morning, Commissioners. I apologize for taking a second bite at the apple and not thinking about this yesterday but it occurred to me that we won't have another chance to see you before the reply briefs are due. And considering the discussion about page limits, a page limit was not set for the reply briefs. And I wanted to submit that you may consider wanting to set one.

I wanted to clarify that the page limit for the opening briefs don't include the Table of Authorities and the Table of Contents. Mr. Wheatland for the applicant had some, you know, concerns about, you know, font size, and those all made perfect sense.

And I also wanted to suggest that you may want to issue the Committee's questions in writing, the eight or so questions that you were most interested in.

HEARING OFFICER CELLI: Okay, that's a good question.

MR. BREHLER: Thank you.

HEARING OFFICER CELLI: Let me ask my committee here; hold on.

(Committee conferring.)

HEARING OFFICER CELLI: Mr. Brehler, thank you for your question. The Committee would first of all state that the 150 page limit would go beyond the Table of Contents and Table of Authorities, et cetera. So the 150 pages would include really your text.

We will attempt to put out today the eight questions asked by way of e-mail to all of the parties.

The 150 page limit would be all briefs, reply briefs, opening briefs, any briefs. One hundred and fifty pages on all briefs, not including Table of Contents, Table of Authorities. So the 150 page limit would be for the opening brief and the 150 page limit would be for the reply or rebuttal briefs.

MR. BREHLER: Thank you very much.

HEARING OFFICER CELLI: Did that cover everything?

MR. BREHLER: Those are all I had. I see no one else here so, thank you.

HEARING OFFICER CELLI: Thank you. And I will put that in the e-mail today. When we send the questions out we'll inform all of the parties of that.

MR. BREHLER: Thank you.

HEARING OFFICER CELLI: Okay, there is nobody in this room who wishes to make a public comment; there are no members of the public here at this time.

It's 9:06 and there is nobody on the WebEx who

wishes to make a comment either so at this time we are going 1 2 to go into closed session. 3 (Off the record at 9:06 a.m.) (On the record at 9:07 a.m.) 4 5 HEARING OFFICER CELLI: Okay, we are back on the 6 record, ladies and gentlemen. The intention of the 7 Committee at this time would be to excuse the court reporter 8 since when we complete the closed session we will return and 9 simply adjourn the meeting without further adieu.
