
Project Description: The 130-megawatt -megawatt King City Cogeneration facility (facility) was certified by the Energy Commission in 1987 and began commercial operation in 1989. The project originally provided steam to Basic American Foods' American 1 Cogeneration Project (Basic) and currently provides steam to Rava Business Park, Inc. (ultimate successor to Basic).

Modification Description: The modifications include removing Engineering Condition of Certification-1 as it is no longer consistent with laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards due to amendments to the Warren-Alquist Act that removed the requirement that the Energy Commission conduct an Integrated Assessment of Need prior to certifying a facility.

On April 10, 2019, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project change pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary for Natural Resources under section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code, finding that:

- The petition meets all the filing criteria of Title 20, section 1769 (a), of the California Code of Regulations, concerning post-certification change in project design, operation, or performance requirements;
- The removal of Engineering Condition of Certification-1 will not change the findings in the Energy Commission's Final Decision, pursuant to Title 20, section 1748, of the California Code of Regulations; and
- The modified facility would not have a significant impact on the environment.
