NOTICE OF RECEIPT TERMINATION OF LICENSE/CLOSURE PLAN FOR INLAND EMPIRE ENERGY CENTER PROJECT (01-AFC-17C)

On June 20, 2019, Inland Empire Energy Center, LLC (IEEC) filed a petition with the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) requesting permanent closure of the facility (TN 228806). IEEC is an 800-megawatt base load gas fired power plant located in the City of Menifee, in southern Riverside County. The project was certified by the Energy Commission on December 17, 2003.

ENERGY COMMISSION REVIEW PROCEDURES

Energy Commission staff is currently reviewing the Closure Plan. The purpose of the Energy Commission's review is to assess the impacts of the proposed Closure Plan on environmental quality and on public health and safety. The review process includes an evaluation of the consistency of the proposed Closure Plan with the Energy Commission's Decision and a determination on whether the closure of the facility would remain in compliance with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations and standards (Cal. Code of Regs., tit. 20, § 1769). After staff has completed its independent review and analysis of the Closure Plan, it will publish its assessment for public review and comment. Upon completion of its review and analysis, staff will provide its written recommendation for consideration by the Energy Commission at a regularly scheduled Business Meeting.
