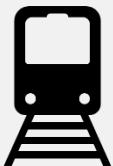

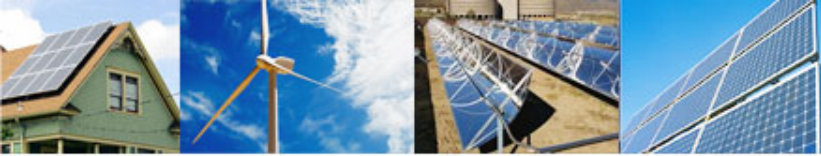

Conclusions

Regional Air Districts

- Future local analysis needed to evaluate the merits of each program
- Measures needed to reduce Rail Transportation emissions

California Air Resources Board

- Updated guidance to air districts for more standardized emissions source identification

California Public Utilities Commission

- Reinstatement of former programs and expansion of current and future programs to target AB 617 community needs
 - E.g. expansion of TE programs to target rail emissions
- Regular communication with CARB and outreach to air districts
