
**Project Description:** The OGS was designed as a 624 megawatt natural gas-fired, combined-cycle electrical generating facility. The project was certified by the Energy Commission on May 18, 2011.

**Modification Description:** The Petition requested the California Energy Commission approval of the permanent closure of the Oakley Generating Station and license termination of the facility.

On August 28, 2018, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project change pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary for Natural Resources under section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code, finding that:

1. The approval of the permanent closure and termination of license of the facility is consistent with all applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards, as required by Condition of Certification COMPLIANCE-11, subject to the provisions of Public Resources Code section 25525; and
2. The permanent closure and termination of license of the facility would have no significant effects on environmental quality, and on public health and safety.

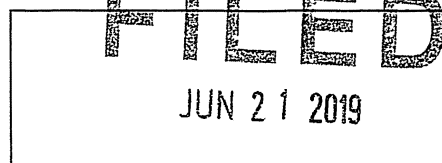
