Per the request of Commission Staff, the City of San Mateo would like to express to you our continuing commitment to enforce the 2019 Title 24, Part 6 Building Energy Efficiency Standards of the California Building Code as part of the implementation of the Green Building Requirements. I will work with staff to provide the appropriate training on enforcement of the energy standards and requirements to comply with the Green Building Standards.

On August 19, 2019, City staff presented the reach code ordinance to City Council. The City Council approved the ordinance at the second reading on September 4, 2019. Additionally, the Council found that, under the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) and 15308 of the CEQA Guidelines, there is no possibility that the implementation of the ordinance will have a significant negative impact on the environment and is thus exempt from the requirements of CEQA.

The City of San Mateo Green Building Standards will ensure that residential and non-residential buildings in the County will consume no more energy than permitted by Title 24, Part 6.
