## **Reform Transmission Access Charge to support local renewables as part of SB100 implementation**

A crucial part of SB100 implementation must be supporting local renewables. Reform Transmission Access Charges (TAC) so that local renewables do not pay TAC charges of 2-3 cents per kWh.
