The urgency of our climate crisis is obvious. What seems less obvious is the urgency of common sense in the pursuit of solutions that will allow us to prevent a catastrophe.

The PUC and ARB have created a policy box in which only electric solutions are considered. Meanwhile our "too-big-to-fail" provider of electricity is coming apart at the seams with no path forward that doesn't involve rate increases that coincide with less reliable service for the next 10 years.

Now is not the time to take away energy options unless there is a cleaner and reliable alternative ready for immediate use. People will need natural gas and propane for another generation at least. Get us affordable electricity from reliable sources before you allow anyone to start restricting the use of low carbon fuels like propane.
