Request for Transfer of Ownership Shell Martinez Refinery Cogeneration Plant**

Dear Ms. Dyas:

In June 2019, Equilon Enterprises LLC (d/b/a Shell Oil Products US) (“Shell”) signed an agreement with PBF Holding Company LLC (“PBF”) for the sale of the Shell Martinez Refinery (the “Refinery”). It is Shell’s understanding that the Refinery will be owned by and operated by a subsidiary of PBF, Martinez Refining Company LLC. The closing of this transaction and thus the transfer of ownership of the Refinery is currently estimated to take place as promptly as possible after February 1, 2020, though the exact date remains to be determined.

The purpose of this letter is to request transfer of ownership of the California Energy Commission (CEC) Certification 93-SPPE-1 (CEC Plant ID G0755) for the Cogeneration Plant located at the Shell Martinez Refinery from Equilon Enterprises LLC (d/b/a Shell Oil Products US) to Martinez Refining Company LLC.

The Refinery requests that the ownership transfer be effective February 1, 2020, pending regulatory approvals and actions. The Refinery will notify the CEC if there are any changes to this schedule.

It is the Refinery’s understanding that CEC will respond in writing to officially acknowledge the change in ownership.
