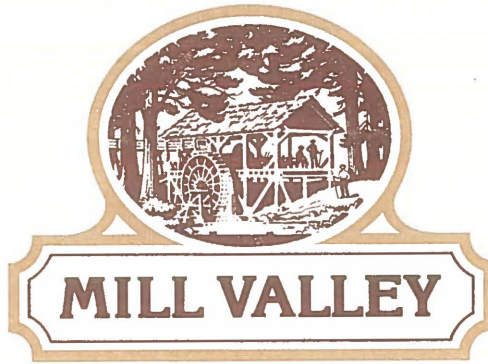

Dear Danuta,

In accordance with Public Resources Code Section 25402.1(h)2 and Section 10-106 of the Building Energy Efficiency Standards, this package of materials includes the City of Mill Valley's proposed local ordinance requiring more stringent energy requirements than those set by California's 2019 Building Energy Efficiency Standards Title 24, Part 6. Please find the following materials enclosed:

- **Att. 1:** This cover letter
- **Att. 2:** Staff report outlining the goals of the updated green building standards
- **Att. 3:** Resolution 19-70 and signed Ordinance No. 1313, which adopts updates the City's Building Ordinance, including requirements for energy reach standards beyond Title 24, Part 6 baseline. This provides clear requirements that buildings be designed to consume no more energy than permitted by Part 6. This also outlines the ordinance's CEQA exemption under California Code of Regulations, Title 14, §15061(b)(3).
- **Att. 4:** Cost effectiveness studies which demonstrate the expected energy savings and the cost effectiveness of the ordinance in Mill Valley (climate zone 3).
- **Att. 5:** A letter from the Chief Building Official to the Executive Director of the CEC about the changes to local green building and building energy efficiency standards.
