


1. **Project Name:** Ordinance Adopting Green Building Amendments to SAN RAFAEL MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLE 12 BUILDING REGULATIONS.
2. **Project Location:** CITY OF SAN RAFAEL
3. **Project Description:** Ordinance amending SAN RAFAEL MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLE 12 BUILDING REGULATIONS to include green building and energy efficiency regulations that apply to THE CITY OF SAN RAFAEL.
4. **Public Agency Approving Project:** SAN RAFAEL CITY COUNCIL
5. **Project Sponsor:** COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT, BUILDING DIVISION
6. **CEQA Exemption Status:** Section 15061(b)(3) and 15308
7. **Reasons for Exemption:** The Ordinance is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. The Ordinance will protect and enhance the environment and SAN RAFAEL'S natural resources by requiring new and remodeled buildings to incorporate green building measures including those related to energy efficiency, water efficiency and conservation, and material conservation and resource efficiency.
