**REDONDO BEACH ENERGY PROJECT  
STATUS REPORT # 14**

Pursuant to the *Revised Committee Scheduling Order* issued on May 7, 2015, AES Southland Development, LLC (the “Applicant”) hereby files this status report to inform the Committee on the progress of the Redondo Beach Energy Project (“Project”) Application for Certification (“AFC”) proceeding.

The Applicant participated in the Preliminary Staff Assessment (“PSA”) Workshop held on May 20-21, 2015, and is currently preparing comments on the PSA. Overall, the Applicant is in substantial agreement with the PSA. The Applicant has identified a few subjects that will require further substantive discussion. These topics were discussed during the workshop and will be described in further detail in our written comments on the PSA.

In its last status report, Staff identified three informational needs from the Applicant: an updated construction and demolition schedule; the air quality cumulative impacts assessment; and a Site Screening and Landscape Concept Plan for review and consideration. As to the first item, the Applicant will submit updated information regarding the construction and demolition schedule in its PSA comments. As to the second item, the Applicant is still working with the South Coast Air Quality Management District to obtain information for a specified emission source to conduct the air quality cumulative impacts analysis requested by Staff. At the PSA Workshop, the Applicant discussed with Staff the difficulties associated with obtaining the information, and alternative means of conducting a conservative cumulative impacts analysis to satisfy Staff’s informational needs. As to the third item, the Applicant will submit a draft

screening plan along with its comments on the PSA. The Applicant will also prepare updated Key Observation Point simulations recommended by Staff on May 27, 2015 (*See*, TN #: 20478). As requested by Staff, we will indicate in our PSA comments when these additional simulations will be completed.
