On November 15, 2019, the Microsoft Corporation (applicant) filed an application with the California Energy Commission (CEC) for a Small Power Plant Exemption (SPPE) for the San Jose City Data Center (project) (19-SPPE-04)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Microsoft Corporation proposes to construct and operate the San Jose City Data Center located at 1657 Alviso-Milpitas Road in San Jose, California. The project consists of two singlestory data center buildings with approximately 479,000 gross square feet of administrative and data center space. The maximum electrical load of the project would be 99 megawatts (MW), inclusive of information technology (IT) equipment, ancillary electrical / telecommunications equipment, and other electrical loads (administrative, heat rejection, and safety/security). To provide reliable operation of the project in the event of loss of electrical service from the local electric utility provider, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), the project includes 40, 3.0-MW standby diesel generators to provide electrical power to support the IT load during utility outages or certain onsite electrical equipment interruptions or failures. These generators would be deployed in redundant configurations (that is, all 40 generators would never be operating at the same time at 100 percent) to ensure uninterrupted power, up to the maximum of 99 MW (with an expected load of 92 MW). In addition to the 40 backup generators, the project would include two administrative generators, rated at 1.25 MW and 0.5 MW, to support administrative functions during an interruption in the normal delivery of electrical power from the utility. The project would also include an onsite 115-kilovolt (kV) substation with two 115-kV electrical supply lines that would connect to PG&E's Los Esteros Substation, located adjacent to the site.

CEC has the exclusive authority to certify all thermal power plants (50 MW and greater) and related facilities proposed for construction in California. The SPPE process allows applicants with facilities between 50 and 100 MW to obtain an exemption from CEC's jurisdiction and proceed with local approval rather than requiring CEC certification. CEC can grant an exemption if it finds that the proposed facility would not create a substantial adverse impact on the environment or energy resources. In this case, the facility is subject to CEC's licensing authority unless the exemption is granted. Should the exemption be granted, the applicant would still need to secure the appropriate licenses and permits for the project from relevant local, state, and federal agencies.

### STAFF EVALUATION OF THE SPPE APPLICATION AND FURTHER STEPS

Public Resources Code section 25519(c) designates CEC as the lead agency, in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), for all facilities seeking an SPPE. CEQA requires the lead agency to consider the whole of the action; therefore, CEC will include the entire project in its analysis, which includes the construction and operation of the data center building, backup generators, and any associated utility connection facilities.
