## **Loud Hissing Noise Plus Strong Chemical Odor in the Air - 8/28/15**

Friday, August 28 around 8:00 PM

the AES Redondo Beach power plant emitted a very loud hissing noise (pressure release valve-type sound) that lasted for about 45 minutes. During this time, there was also a **STRONG** chemical odor in the air noticeable in the adjacent neighborhood. The air was caustic and caused some burning in my throat and some light-headed feelings. Not a god sign for my health or my neighbors.

Redondo Beach Fire and Police responded to the scene.

As a neighbor to the AES plant, I would like to lodge a formal complaint against AES for this noise and air quality violation.

What chemicals were released in to the air? Did this chemical release violate clean air regulations? Did the loud hissing noise violate noise ordinances?

We are keen to learn about what chemical exposure us neighbors are being subjected to as well as learn what caused the incident and what danger this posed to the surrounding community.
