APPLICANT'S STATUS REPORT #3

This Status Report #3 is submitted pursuant to the Committee Scheduling Order dated November 13, 2006.

Discovery Status

Applicant submitted Data Response Set 1D on February 2, 2007. Applicant received a second set of Data Requests from CEC staff on February 2, 2007, and is in the process of preparing responses.

Air Quality

The South Coast Air Quality Management District ("SCAQMD") staff has released a number of proposals for further amending SCAQMD Rule 1309.1 – Priority Reserve. The implications for the Vernon Power Plant will depend on which of the staff proposals, if any, the SCAQMD Board adopts. The SCAQMD Board has set a public hearing for March 2, 2007, to consider adoption of proposed amendments to the rule.

With regard to the air quality issues discussed in the California Energy Commission's ("CEC") Status Report #1 (dated January 18, 2007), and Applicant's Status Report #2:

- Applicant is continuing to investigate the PM2.5 emission mitigation strategy; however, at this time Applicant cannot provide a date when any additional mitigation proposals will be submitted to the CEC.
- Regarding a local mitigation strategy for criteria pollutants and air toxics, the Applicant is actively working with the SCAQMD on this issue; however, at this time Applicant cannot provide a date when any local mitigation strategies will be provided to the CEC.
- Regarding the air quality cumulative impact assessment, the Applicant still is awaiting data from the SCAQMD needed to perform the analysis. Information was requested from the SCAQMD through a Freedom of Information Act request. The

Applicant anticipates being able to provide the requested analysis to the CEC by the end of February 2007.

• The Applicant understands that the SCAQMD is currently working on the Preliminary Determination of Compliance ("PDOC") for the proposed Vernon Power Plant. The Applicant expects the SCAQMD will complete the PDOC in March 2007 (original anticipated date was mid-January 2007).

Public Health

Related to the issue of additional local public health studies, the Applicant is working to identify any public health studies affecting the cities of Maywood and Huntington Park that were not already provided in Appendix 8.6B of the Application for Certification ("AFC"). Any additional public health studies identified, will be provided to the CEC as part of Applicant's responses to the second set of Data Requests (dated February 2, 2007).
