This letter concerns a recent motion in the Application for Certification (AFC) for the Redondo Beach Energy Project. The California Energy Commission is conducting proceedings on the application by AES Southland, LLC, to re-power the existing Redondo Beach Generating Station and eliminate once-through cooling using ocean water.

The Commission recently received a motion by the City of Redondo Beach, an intervenor in the AFC proceeding, (City) for the issuance of a subpoena. The subpoena is directed to both the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and Southern California Edison. A copy of the motion is enclosed.

The subpoena would allow the City to obtain information regarding the recent responses that Southern California Edison received to its Request for Offers under the CPUC's 2014 Long-Term Procurement Plan. In specific, the City has requested the names and locations of the approximately 195 proposals that were not selected by Southern California Edison. The City has represented that it sought the information pursuant to the California Public Records Act but that the CPUC denied the request, citing confidentiality of the information.
