## RULING ON MICROSOFT CORPORATION DATA REQUEST SET #5 EXTENSION REQUEST

On November 15, 2019, Microsoft Corporation (Applicant) submitted an application to the California Energy Commission (CEC) for a small power plant exemption (SPPE) for the San Jose City Backup Generating Facility. The CEC appointed a committee (Committee) to conduct proceedings on the SPPE at its December 11, 2019, Business Meeting.<sup>2</sup>

On May 6, 2020, CEC Staff (Staff) issued Data Request Set 5 to Applicant,<sup>3</sup> which Staff explained was a follow up to Applicant's Response to question 53 in Data Request Set 3.<sup>4</sup> Data Request Set 5 seeks additional information on the revised electrical interconnection between Pacific Gas & Electric's (PG&E) Los Esteros Substation and the San Jose City Data Center onsite substation, including information on anticipated reliability.

On May 26, 2020, Applicant filed "Data Request Set 5 Extension Request" (Motion).<sup>5</sup> In its Motion, Applicant explains that it is relying upon PG&E to provide the responses to the requested information. Applicant states that COVID-related issues have impeded PG&E's ability to timely respond, but that Applicant anticipates it will be able to substantively respond and provide the requested data by July 7, 2020.

The deadline for filing a response to the Motion was 14 days from the date of service of the motion, or June 9, 2020.<sup>6</sup> No opposition was submitted in response to Applicant's Motion.

Based on good cause appearing and the lack of objection, the Committee hereby **GRANTS** Applicant's Motion. Applicant is **ORDERED** to provide the requested data on or before July 31, 2020.
