I am in construction an have installed several of these back up generators for data centers. However the proposed location is extremely close to residential areas and with the unreliability that PG&E has shown last year to keep the power on; these could run for several days at a time. It is my experience that in the past during wildfires the smoke gets caught up against the hills and stagnates unless there is a high wind to push it away. If this situation occurs than the amount of pollutants from these diesel generators would accumulate and pose a threat to the health of the whole community living along the hills. Please reconsider moving this closer to 101 where it is further from residents and is not so close to the hills where the exhaust fumes can pool for long periods of time.
