PETITION FOR POST CERTIFICATION PROJECT CHANGE
GEYSERS CALISTOGA, UNIT 19 (81-AFC-01C)

On June 24, 2020, the Calpine Corporation filed a post certification petition with the California Energy Commission (CEC) for the Geysers Calistoga, Unit 19 project. The 176.4 megawatt (MW) project was certified by the CEC in February 1982 and began commercial operation in March 1984. The facility is located at 10350 Socrates Mine Road, Middletown, Sonoma County California.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED CHANGES

This request includes the following changes:

- To install a permanent standby skid-mounted diesel engine-powered pump as part of the cooling tower wet-down system. The installation includes auxiliaries such as the pump control system, dual-walled fuel tank, and batteries.
